- I. CALL TO ORDER- Carla Monson called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.
- II. STUDENT GOVERNMENT REPORT- Maddy Brown updated the Board with Flash, next Thursday, 6-8PM which is a pep-rally for homecoming and homecoming week. Cost is \$5.00 and open to all students and parents of dancers. Homecoming Game is Friday at 7:00 at Chaparral with a tail gate before including a hotdog food truck and a desert/cotton candy food truck. Everyone is welcome. Homecoming is 8-11PM at Salt River Fields with a theme of Rock –n-roll Tickets are \$35 in advance and \$40 at the door. Students will need their student IDs. Also next week will be Spirit Week with different dress up days. Monday- Sports Day, Tuesday-Tie dye day, Wednesday-Firebird Day, Thursday-Hawaiian Day, Friday-USA Day. The Birdcage is a USA Theme for support of Hurricane Harvey and Hurricane Irma. SOS is teaming up with STUGO to help decorate the school for the week.
- III. CHAPPARRAL SOCIAL WORKER/PREVENTION COACH- Mindy Hickman spoke about The Healath and Wellness Program to provide substance abuse and intervention at the campus. There was a 3- year \$150,000.00 grant given to Chaparral and she showed us why we need these services. Healthy, positive, safe life choices are the key function of teaching students these skills. Arizona Youth Survey is given to students in 8-12<sup>th</sup> grade for risk and protective factors. The results were staggering. The grant is a prevention of substance abuse to provide programs and services for High School students. Goal #1- help identify reasons why drinking and using drugs is not safe. Goal #2- Goal #3 learn to talk to parents. Classroom curriculum will be used as well as an assembly on September 22<sup>nd</sup> with the Scottsdale police and fire department and a speaker. Education is key to awareness. 9<sup>th</sup> Grade PE classes will have a 10 week program by Not My Kid. There is a STUGO meeting to help design posters and social media creative to help get awareness out. Enviornmental is a huge part of this program as far as talking to your kids about this potential problem. There will be an opt-out form that will go home.
- IV. PRINCIPAL REPORT- Dr. Chomokos reported that we are adding 5 sections of classess, impacting 6 courses total. We are asking for volunteers to make the switch and then will have to move others if needed. Some of the classes will be impacted. A letter will be received if your child is affected.
