CHAPTS – General Meeting Minutes – October 2, 2017

- I. CALL TO ORDER – Carla Monson called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.
- II. STUDENT GOVERNMENT REPORT- Homecoming was not a great turnout for Junior and Senior Class although the week was busy. STUGO thought it was a success with about 500 attending mostly freshman and sophomores. The Blood Drive is on Thursday so sophomores have been handing out donor permits and they are taking care of it. The event is for 16 years and older. We are sending the blood to Las Vegas to help with their needs from the massacre. There may or may not be a Winter Formal.
- III. SCHOOL CLUBS REPORT-
 - a. Riley Glick and Cole Karney presented a request on Science Olympiad. The money they are requesting will be used for registration fees in order to be able to compete in different events. Materials are also needed for building events that are used for competition.
- IV. PRINCIPAL UPDATE- Dr. Angela Chomkos reported starting with athletics saying both boys and girls golf have qualified for State as well as Volleyball, swim and cross-country. Football will need to do well the rest of the season to make it into State. Oct. 30th is Winter Sports try-outs. Dec. 12 is anticipated start date for track. Counselors were asked to help with any students that may be affected with the Las Vegas tragedy. The beautification program has started with a meeting with Dennis who said that he has a landscape architect on retainer through the district. The Bond allocation of money was also discussed and the project is moving forward. In addition, the A-F labels will be released soon. Dr. Chomokos stated that Homecoming was a very nice event and very well done. Dr. Chomokos did state a concern with the absentee rate that she feels is pretty substantial. She spoke about the late start and how it changed for the PSAT because of the number of students who are taking the test, faculty needed for proctors and we don't have enough left to teach classes. Dr. Chomokos also had a concern about giving another day for the Staff Costume contest and suggested it was not something she was encouraging because she didn't want to take another day away from the school day.
