- I. CALL TO ORDER- Carla Monson called the meeting to order at 6:30.
- II. STUDENT GOVERNMENT REPORT- Will Owens reported that Homecoming was awesome with an amazing turn out with a huge turnout. Yavapai Toy Drive for 2 weeks is coming up. The Play Big Game (usually a big football game to support Samantha Stachel) and we are doing with Basketball instead of Football on Jan. 5th.
- III. SCHOOL CLUBS REPORT
 - a. **Chaparral Sports Medicine Club**- Josh Paul presented that their aim is to create an environment and a club for students currently enrolled in the Sports Medicine Class. They will enrich their knowledge with that being their end goal. He also said that anyone is welcome to join the club. The money would go toward creating fundraisers to be able to purchase materials/tools to practice more hands on training. Any extra money would go back into the trainers at Chaparral.
